

FITEC TAKES THE STREETS OF GETAFE: SEPTEMBER 25, 26 and 27.

A new edition of FITEC (International Street Theatre Festival) takes the streets and squares of Getafe to meet up again with viewers of the city that is the headquarters for already 18 editions that the Festival plays in this year 2015.

Getafe and FITEC are closely linked since the Festival was born back in 1995, and both flows the same DNA, feeling part of each other.

Despite the downturn supported by FITEC over the past three years, this returns to rise from its ashes shouting paraphrase Fray Luis de Leon, "... As we were saying yesterday ...". And then it happened, today claimed FITEC of new space in the arteries of the city, trying to weigh this as a time to rethink the Festival forward and face this new stage.

Thus, the Destellos Theater Company and the Getafe City Council, we breathed new life into Festival, and melting in a single entity, open the FITEC participation and the flow of new experiences to our viewers as well as with companies and entities the city.

This year 2015 the Festival tries to recover its former spaces and opening new ones in order to reach as it could not be otherwise, as many potential viewers. Thus, the traditional FITEC runs TOWN HALL square, PALACIO square, front of CENTRAL RENFE square, MADRID street, HOSPITALILLO intersection, HOSPITALILLO patio, TOWN HALL roof, front of LORCA THEATER square, opposite and the LORCA THEATER own; and we introduce what we have called THE AVIARY (inside the Lorenzo Azofra park) and the BISHOP TERRACE (located on the terrace of parking in the Bishop Felipe Scio square)... And then we come to the neighborhoods of our city: THE BERCIAL (in Aviocar Park located in the Salvador Allende avenue), Perales del Río (in the square opposite the main entrance of the new cultural center Julian Marias), CERRO BUENAVISTA (in square wooden arch located on José Giral ride) and THE MILLS (opposite to the works which will set the new Mercadona shopping center).

A novelty this year in which we fulfill the majority, has been the incorporation of Professional Companies of Getafe and local cultural entities and not only to participation as companies performing at the Festival and have been doing so far, but the actual design of proposals FITEC as an integral and active part of the proposal that makes this year the Festival program.

A new feature of this edition also the Festival expands the Art-FITEC artisanal Market, which will run from DON FADRIQUE street to the square forming the confluence of RAMON Y CAJAL street and FERROCARRIL avenue, winding its way through BISHOP FELIPE SCIO square, FELIPE ESTEVEZ street and PABLO IGLESIAS ride.

The Festival program is full of performances and activities in the streets and squares of the city, reaching a total of 89 performances scheduled theater, dance, music, circus and puppet held by a total of 28 companies in its official section plus other 8 in its OFF section, plus the addition of exhibitions and interventions in public and games and workshops across the street from our "Go to Play to the Street" claiming the urban and public space as well as a natural space to play.

We hope everyone in the streets of Getafe.
